



IS THE UE TELLING ME THE TRUTH?

The United Electrical, Radio and Machine Workers of America ("UE") are trying to get team members to sign union authorization cards. Before signing a card, make sure you get all the facts because:

The UE is Not Playing by the Same Rules as Wabtec

➤ Under the labor law, an employer is **prohibited** from making any promises. In contrast, the UE can make any promise it wants. Don't believe us, here is the law:

Unions can "Promise wage increases and better benefits, even though they have no actual power to guarantee those things, because those promises are considered mere "pre-election propaganda."

Shirlington Supermarket, Inc., 106 N.L.R.B. 666 (1953).

Unions can "Issue misleading campaign propaganda" because the NLRB does not think employees are "naïve" enough to believe all that they are told in the course of a union election campaign."

Shopping Kart Food Market, Inc., 228 N.L.R.B. 1311 (1977).

Think critically about what the UE is telling you! If the UE makes you a promise, tell them to put it in **writing!**
